## **ITINERARY:**



### **DAY 01 – ANCHORAGE (D) (3-hour guided city tour of Anchorage)**

Arrive at Anchorage, upon arrival at Anchorage Airport, you will be greeted by our representative who will assist with your transfer to the hotel. After check-in, (3 PM) take some time to relax and freshen up. In the afternoon, embark on a **3-hour guided city tour of Anchorage** led by a professional local guide. Explore key highlights of city. Later in the evening, the group will gather for a dinner at an Indian restaurant—an ideal opportunity to meet fellow travelers and begin your Alaskan journey together. Overnight stay in Anchorage.



### **DAY 02 – ANCHORAGE (B, L, D) Kenai Fjords National Park**

After breakfast, the group will be picked up from the hotel and depart at 8:30 for **Kenai Fjords National Park (approx. 2.5-hour drive)**. Enjoy the scenic journey through the stunning landscapes of the Kenai Peninsula. Upon arrival, proceed to the cruise check-in at (available time). **Enjoy a 4-hour narrated wildlife and glacier cruise** through Resurrection Bay, with commentary provided by the captain and accompanied by a dedicated guide for the group. Witness breathtaking views of rugged coastlines, marine wildlife, and alpine glaciers. **Lunch will be served onboard**. The cruise concludes at 4:00 PM, after which the group will begin the return journey to Anchorage (approx. 2.5 hours). Relax and enjoy the scenic drive back. Upon arrival in Anchorage the group will enjoy a dinner at an Indian restaurant, reflecting on the incredible experiences shared. After dinner, transfer back to the hotel. Overnight stay in Anchorage.



### **DAY 03 Anchorage to Denali (B, L, D)**

After breakfast, check out, and the group will proceed to Talkeetna by Coach (Approx 3 hrs.' drive). Orientation tour of **historic Talkeetna**, Later Relax by the **Talkeetna River**, or later proceed to Denali National Park, Visit the Denali **Sled dog kennels and attend demo or ranger talk (based on availability only)** Lunch and dinner at a restaurant, check in to the hotel, and overnight at Denali. Check into the hotel and overnight.



### **DAY 04 – Denali National Park (B, L, D) Tundra Wilderness Tour (Based on availability)**
