## **HAWAII LAND TOUR**

**Sept 19 – Sept 29**

**10 Night / 11 Days**

### **Day 1 – Sept 19 - Arrival in Kona (Big Island).**

Aloha and welcome to Hawai'i. Upon arrival at Kona International Airport, complete immigration and baggage formalities and meet your local representative for a transfer to the hotel. Check in and take time to relax after your journey or explore the nearby area at your own pace. Overnight in Kona.

### **Day 2 – Big Island Volcano Adventure Tour.**

Discover the dramatic origins of Hawaii at Hawai'i Volcanoes National Park. This comprehensive tour showcases volcanic landscapes, waterfalls, rainforests, and historic Hilo town. **(Breakfast, Indian Dinner)**

- Scenic drive through Hilo Town, Banyan Drive & Liliuokalani Gardens



### **Day 3 – Kona → Maui.**

After breakfast, check out from your hotel in Kona and transfer to the airport for your short inter-island flight to Maui. This scenic hop usually takes about 40–50 minutes in the air, giving you beautiful views of the Pacific Ocean and neighboring islands, weather permitting. Once you land in Maui, collect your bags and transfer to the hotel. After check-in, the rest of the day is at leisure to relax, stroll along the beach, or explore nearby shops and cafes at your own pace. **(Breakfast, Local Dinner)**

## Day 4 – Haleakalā Sunset Tour (with local Dinner)

Experience a breathtaking sunset from the summit of Haleakalā National Park at 9,740 ft.

### Tour Highlights:

- Haleakalā National Park admission included
- Ranger Station stops
- Silversword plants and possible Nēnē Goose sightings
- Sunset viewing from the summit
- Haleakalā Visitor Center
- Scenic descent through Upcountry Maui
- Mini-coach tour with panoramic windows

## Day 5 – Road to Hana Tour (with Lunch)

## Day 6 – Maui → Honolulu (Oahu)

This morning, enjoy breakfast and some free time before checking out of your Maui hotel. You will then be transferred to the airport for your inter-island flight to Honolulu on Oahu, which typically takes about 40–45 minutes. During the flight, you may catch glimpses of Molokai, Lanai, or other islands as you travel across the Hawaiian island chain. Upon arrival in Honolulu, transfer to your hotel and complete check-in formalities. The evening is free to unwind on the famous Waikiki beachfront or explore the lively neighborhood dining options on your own. **(Breakfast Indian Dinner)**

## Day 9 – Honolulu (Oahu) → Kauai (Inter-island Flight)

After breakfast, check out from your hotel in Honolulu and transfer to the airport for your inter-island flight to the “Garden Isle” of Kauai. The flight duration is approximately 35–45 minutes and, weather permitting, offers breathtaking aerial views of Hawaii’s rugged coastlines and lush green valleys. Upon arrival in Kauai, proceed for a visit to the Kauai Hindu Monastery, including the tranquil Rudraksha Forest. *Please note that entry to the temple and monastery premises is subject to prior approval by the resident monks and local guidelines.* Later, transfer to your hotel and complete the check-in process. The remainder of the day is at leisure—you may relax by the pool, enjoy a gentle walk along the beach, or simply unwind and rest in preparation for the sightseeing planned the following day.

## Day 10- Waimea Canyon, Wailua River & Fern Grotto Tour

### Grand Valleys, Meandering Rivers & Lush Jungles

Experience Kauai’s wonderous marvels on the Waimea Canyon\*, Wailua River and Fern Grotto Tour. Journey to one of the world’s most inspiring geological wonders, the Waimea Canyon and be amazed at the expansive peaks, valleys, and deep gorges. Cruise down the Wailua River on a scenic boat ride amidst a lush rainforest jungle and take a relaxing stroll to the Fern Grotto. Witness nature’s raw power at the Spouting Horn Blowhole on this tour showcasing the scenic splendor of Kauai.

The Waimea Canyon Lookout will be closed from July 14 through approximately December 8, 2025 for slope and foundation repairs. We’ll substitute it with stop at Pu’uhinahina Lookout, which offers a different but impressive view of Waimea Canyon. We’ll also make a few additional photo stops to give guests more time to enjoy the scenery.

### Highlights

- Waimea Canyon – nicknamed “The Grand Canyon of the Pacific”, this epic natural wonder is over 10 miles long, 1 mile wide and more than 3,000 feet deep. The Waimea Canyon Lookout offers scenic views of the deep valley gorges with its striking red soil covered in greenery.
- ‘Ōpaeka‘a Falls – This 151-foot-tall, 40-foot-wide waterfall is the most accessible major waterfalls on Kauai. ‘Ōpaeka‘a” means “rolling shrimp,” which were once abundant in the stream.
- Spouting Horn Blowhole – crashing waves propel majestic jets of salt water through lava rock. One of the most photographed sites on Kauai.
- Hanapepe Valley Lookout – panoramic views of a valley covered in trees and wild green sugarcane. Hanapepe was one of the locations visited by famous explorer Charles Wilkes in 1840 on his United States Exploring Expedition.
- Wailua River – narrated two-mile ride on an open-air boat down a meandering freshwater river.
- Fern Grotto – at the end of the Wailua River, walk through a tropical rainforest to a rock cave dripping in ferns. Listen to the melodious, live performance of the Hawaiian wedding song as you enjoy the verdant surroundings. **(Breakfast, Local Dinner)**



## Day 11- September 29

Today your memorable Hawaiian adventure comes to an end. After breakfast, enjoy some free time to relax at the hotel, take a final stroll on the beach, or do any last-minute shopping for souvenirs and local treats. Depending on your international flight schedule, you will check out of the hotel and transfer to the airport in time for your return journey. Please ensure your baggage is within the airline's weight limits and keep your travel documents and valuables in your hand baggage. Board your flight with wonderful memories of the Hawaiian Islands, their natural beauty, and shared experiences with your fellow travelers, as you head back home. **(Breakfast)**
