Day 1: Oct 1- Arrive Edinburgh

Arrive in Edinburgh, Scotland's majestic capital, beautifully set between rugged hills and the sparkling waters of the Firth of Forth. A city of dramatic landscapes, medieval alleys, and Georgian elegance, Edinburgh effortlessly blends ancient history with modern culture. Upon arrival, meet your Tour Manager and transfer to the hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is free to relax or explore nearby Princes Street, enjoy local cafés, or take a gentle evening stroll along the Royal Mile. Enjoy a welcome dinner with your group. Overnight stay in Edinburgh. (Meals: D)

Day 2: Guided city tour of Edinburgh-Edinburgh Castle – Scenic Cruise

After breakfast proceed to guided tour of Edinburgh which is Scotland's compact, hilly capital. It has a medieval Old Town and elegant Georgian New Town with gardens and neoclassical buildings. Looming over the city is Edinburgh Castle, home to Scotland's crown jewels and the Stone of Destiny, used in the coronation of Scottish rulers. Arthur's Seat is an imposing peak in Holyrood Park with sweeping views, and Calton Hill is topped with monuments and memorials, post lunch enjoy the Edinburgh cruise, later proceed to Indian dinner at a restaurant and back to your hotel. Overnight at Edinburgh. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 3: Edinburgh – Perth - Scone Palace – Into the Scottish Highlands -Inverness

Today after breakfast, Depart northward into the heart of Scotland. Stop in Perth, once Scotland's ancient capital, and visit the grand Scone Palace — the historic crowning place of Scottish kings including Macbeth and Robert the Bruce. Explore its elegant interiors, priceless antiques, and magnificent gardens. Continue your journey into the legendary Scottish Highlands — a land of dramatic mountains, misty glens, cascading rivers, and tranquil lochs. The landscape becomes increasingly wild and breathtaking as you approach Inverness. Arrive in Inverness, the cultural capital of the Highlands, beautifully located on the River Ness. overnight stay in Inverness. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 4: Inverness – Loch Ness – Highland Legends

Today after breakfast, explore Inverness on a guided orientation tour. See Inverness Castle and stroll along the River Ness. Today's highlight is the world-famous Loch Ness — a deep, mysterious loch known worldwide for the legend of the Loch Ness Monster. Enjoy scenic views of the dramatic Highland landscape. Stop at the atmospheric ruins of Urquhart Castle for photographs. The castle offers stunning panoramic views across the loch and provides insight into medieval Scottish clan history. Return to Inverness in the evening. Overnight at Inverness. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 5: Highland Scenery – Loch Lomond – Glasgow

After Breakfast, Check-out, Travel south through spectacular Highland scenery. Stop at: • Fort Augustus (famous for Caledonian Canal locks) • Fort William (at the foot of Ben Nevis, the UK's highest mountain) Arrive at the serene Loch Lomond, one of Scotland's most picturesque lakes. Enjoy a relaxing cruise surrounded by rolling hills and peaceful waters. Continue to Glasgow, Scotland's largest city, known for its Victorian architecture, music scene, and vibrant personality. Overnight stay in Glasgow. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 6: Glasgow Guided City Tour - Cairnryan Ferry – Belfast

After a breakfast, Check-out and proceed to guided city of Glasgow. Explore Glasgow on a guided city tour. See George Square, Glasgow Cathedral, the River Clyde, and the vibrant Merchant City district. Learn about Glasgow's transformation from an industrial powerhouse to a modern cultural capital. Later, transfer to Cairnryan to board the ferry across the Irish Sea. Enjoy scenic sea views during your crossing to Belfast, the dynamic capital of Northern Ireland. Upon arrival, transfer to your hotel. On arrival dinner and hotel check-in. Overnight at Belfast. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 7: Belfast – Guided city tour - Titanic Experience – Giant's Causeway

After breakfast, begin with a guided city tour of Belfast, seeing City Hall, Queen's University, and the famous political murals that reflect the city's complex history. Visit the world-renowned Titanic Belfast, located at the historic shipyard where the RMS Titanic was built. This interactive museum tells the complete story of the ship from conception to its tragic voyage. Later, travel along the scenic Antrim Coast to the extraordinary Giant's Causeway, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Marvel at the unique hexagonal basalt columns formed by ancient volcanic activity and steeped in Irish legend. Return to Belfast. Overnight at Belfast. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 8: Belfast - Scenic Coastal Drive to Galway

After breakfast, check out, depart for Galway, travelling via Derry, known for its well-preserved 17th-century walls. Continue along scenic coastal routes passing Tullan Strand, famous for golden sands and Atlantic views, and Benbulbin, an iconic flat-topped mountain. Arrive in Galway, often called Ireland's cultural heart, famous for traditional music, colorful streets, and lively atmosphere. On arrival dinner and hotel check-in overnight in Galway. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 9: Galway City tour - Cliffs of Moher- Galway

After a breakfast, enjoy a guided walking tour of Galway, exploring Eyre Square, Spanish Arch, and the Latin Quarter filled with pubs and artisan shops.

Later, visit the spectacular Cliffs of Moher, rising 214 meters above the Atlantic Ocean. These dramatic cliffs offer breathtaking views and are one of Ireland's most photographed natural wonders. Return to Galway for dinner and back to hotel Overnight at Galway. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 10: Galway – Killarney national park | Scenic Southwest Ireland – Cork

After breakfast, check out and proceed to Cork and journey south toward the enchanting town of Killarney, located in County Kerry — one of Ireland's most picturesque regions. The drive itself is a visual delight, passing rolling green countryside, charming villages, and classic Irish farmland. Upon arrival, visit the breathtaking Killarney National Park, Ireland's first national park and a UNESCO Biosphere Reserve. The Park is renowned for its pristine lakes, ancient oak woodlands, waterfalls, and the majestic MacGillycuddy's Reeks Mountain range. Enjoy scenic views of the Lakes of Killarney and learn about the park's rich natural and cultural heritage. Later, enjoy a guided orientation tour of Killarney town, known for its colorful shopfronts, lively atmosphere, and traditional Irish charm. The town beautifully blends natural beauty with warm hospitality and is a favorite stop along the famous Ring of Kerry route. Later proceed to Cork. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay in Cork (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 11: Cork – Dublin | Capital Highlights & Guinness Experience

Today after breakfast check out and proceed to Cork, Ireland's second-largest city and often called the "Real Capital of Ireland" by locals. Cork is a vibrant city built on islands in the River Lee and is known for its strong maritime history and independent spirit. Upon arrival, enjoy a guided city tour covering the main highlights, including the impressive St. Fin Barre's Cathedral with its striking Gothic Revival architecture. Pass by the famous English Market, one of Europe's oldest covered markets, known for its artisan foods and local produce. Explore Cork's charming streets lined with cafés, boutiques, and colorful buildings while learning about the city's rich trading past and cultural heritage. Later travel to Dublin, Ireland's lively capital city — a dynamic blend of literary history, Georgian elegance, and vibrant pub culture. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch followed by a comprehensive guided city tour. See the historic Trinity College Dublin, Ireland's oldest university, famous for the Book of Kells. Conclude your visit at the Gravity Bar, where you can enjoy a tasting while admiring panoramic views of Dublin's skyline. Dinner at the hotel. Overnight stay in Dublin. (Meals: B, L, D)

Day 12: Oct 12 - Departure | Farewell Ireland

After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Transfer to Dublin Airport for your onward flight home. As your journey concludes, depart with unforgettable memories of Ireland's dramatic Highlands and Ireland's stunning coastlines, historic cities, warm hospitality, and rich Celtic heritage. (Meals: B)
