SEPTEMBER 23RD – OCTOBER 1ST

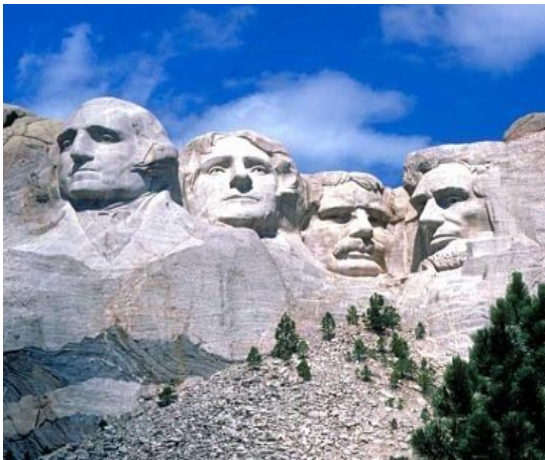
Rapid city - Mount Rushmore – Cody - Yellow Stone national park - Grand Teton National Park – Jackson Hole - Salt Lake City- Bryce Canyon National Park - Zion National Park – Las Vegas.

DAY 01 EWR - Rapid City

Fly from NJ to Rapid City. It's known as a gateway to Mt. Rushmore, the massive iconic sculpture of 4 U.S. presidents. "City of Presidents," a series of life-size statues, spans several blocks downtown. Upon arrival proceed to hotel and check in. **Overnight in Rapid City. (Dinner)**

DAY 02 Rapid City - Mount Rushmore



After breakfast proceed to Mount Rushmore to visit the **Crazy Horse Memorial**, started over 50 years ago by Chief Henry Standing Bear who invited sculptors to carve a mountain honoring the heritage, tradition and culture of North American Indians. Then, on to the magnificent **Mount Rushmore National Memorial, the largest statue-monument in the world.** The faces of four American presidents - George Washington, Thomas Jefferson, Theodore Roosevelt and Abraham Lincoln - are carved into the granite mountainside high above the treetops of the Black Hills. The carving took 14 years to complete and serves today as a priceless shrine of democracy. In the evening enjoy all the splendor of Mount Rushmore National Monument in the magic of the evening **Lighting Ceremony.**

Overnight in Rapid City. (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

DAY 03- Drive to Cody



Morning departure to Sheridan, Wyoming set between Yellowstone and Mount Rushmore, with its dramatic vistas of the striking Big Horn Mountains. The town's authentic Main Street is lined with historic buildings, offering Old West appeal in a modern setting. After lunch, continue to Cody for an afternoon arrival.

DAY 04- Cody - Onto Yellowstone National Park - **Yellowstone National Park West**



We arrive Yellow Stone national park, a breathtaking natural wonderland established in 1872 as the first national park in the United States. We visit Old Faithful, Grand Prismatic Spring, and Fountain Paint Pot legendary Excelsior Geyser Basin

DAY 05- Yellowstone National Park **NORTHERN YELLOWSTONE & GRAND CANYON AREA**



- After breakfast at hotel proceed to Northern Yellowstone & Grand Canyon Area, Visit Mammoth Hot Springs. Grand Canyon of Yellowstone and Lower Falls. Visit Tower Falls.

Day 6 Jackson Hole - Grand Teton National Park - Salt Lake City



After breakfast, we will travel to **Grand Teton National Park**. Grand Teton National Park is simply stunning. Snow-capped mountains and 12 peaks rise more than 12,000 feet above sea level. A string of jewel-like lakes, fed by mountain streams, are set tightly against the steep foot of the mountains. Jackson Hole Mountain Resort has the longest continuous vertical rise of any ski area in the U.S after spending some time at **Jackson Hole**, we will head to Salt Lake City, UT

DAY 07: Salt Lake City - Bryce Canyon National Park



After breakfast we, enjoy guided city tour of SLC and further head to **Bryce Canyon National Park**. The limited archeological findings indicate that this area was used primarily for hunting with most habitation in the river **valleys** below. Over time, erosion has carved colorful limestone into thousands of spires, fins, arches and mazes. The formations collectively called "hoodoos," and are arranged and tinted with various colors.

Day 08 Bryce Canyon National Park - Zion National Park – Las Vegas City Tour



After breakfast proceed to **Zion National Park**. The name Zion is a Hebrew word meaning a place of refuge. Experience the dramatic landscape of sculptured canyons and soaring cliffs. Zion National Park's canyons and mesas boast an especially exquisite beauty, even in a state known for dramatic landscapes. Breathtaking Zion Canyon is the centerpiece of this 147,000-acre parkland that protects a spectacular landscape of high plateaus, sheer canyons, and monolithic cliffs. Carved by water and time, **Zion National Park is a canyon that invites you**

to participate in the very forces that created it. We reach Las Vegas late evening and relax.
